

RICoC Standing Committees

The Rhode Island Continuum of Care (RICoC) has eight (8) standing committees made up of volunteers who help manage the Continuum's day-to-day operations. These committees assist the RICOc in its routine functions and may offer recommendations or advice to the Board. Constituent Advisory Committee

The Committee also develops and oversees the operation of grievance procedures for agencies related to RICoC funding decisions, including grievances of agencies whose applications for funding have not been approved by the RICoC.
